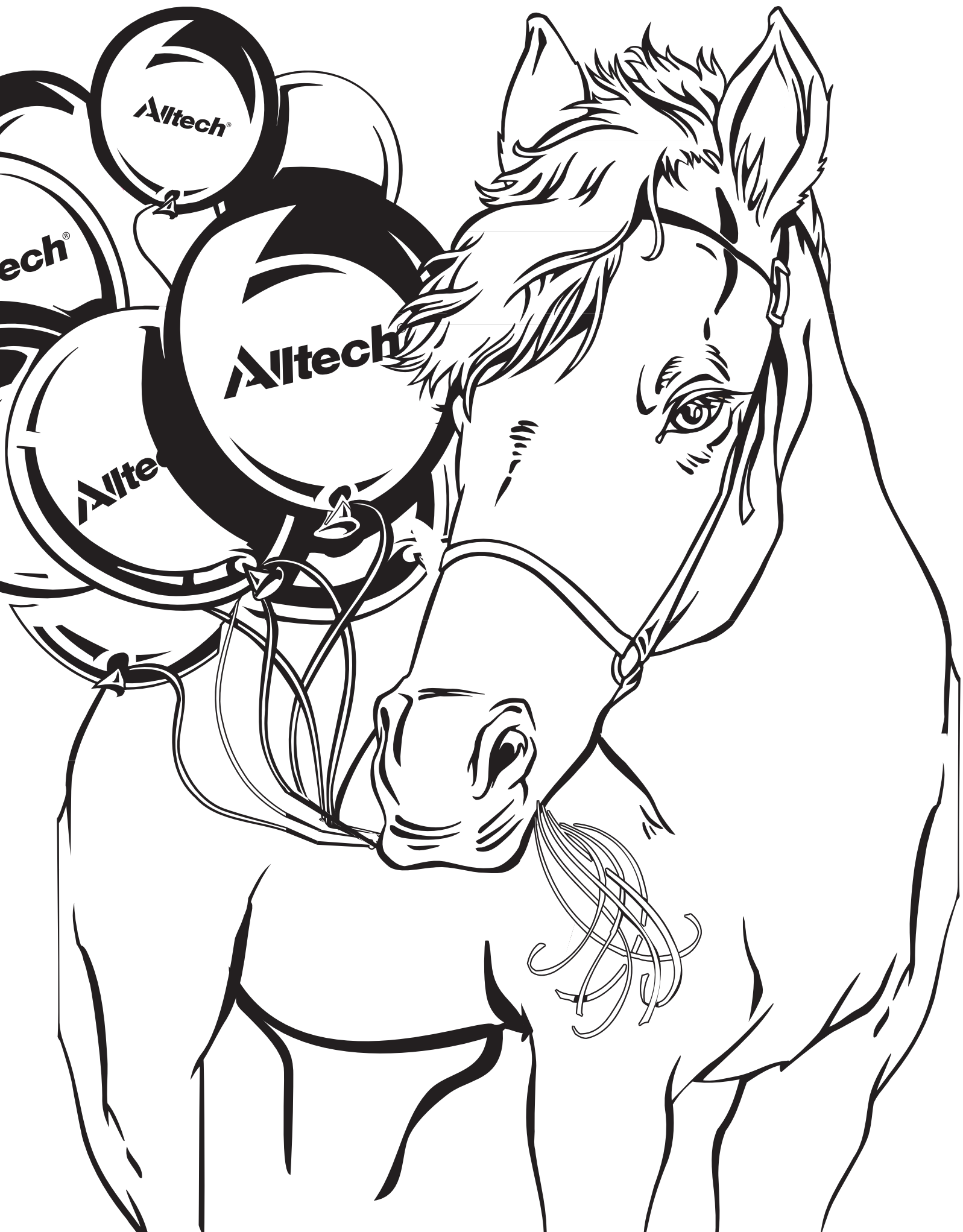

The Alltech FEI World Equestrian Games are a competition for horses from all over the world competing in 8 different events. These events are called Dressage, Endurance, Eventing, Vaulting, Reining, Show Jumping, Driving, and Para-Equestrian. The Alltech FEI Games will take place in Lexington, KY from September 25 through October 10, in the year 2010. It will be the largest sporting event for horses ever held in the United States. More than 500 million people around the world will be able to watch the games on TV and more than 700,000 people are expected to actually come to Lexington, KY to see the games in person!

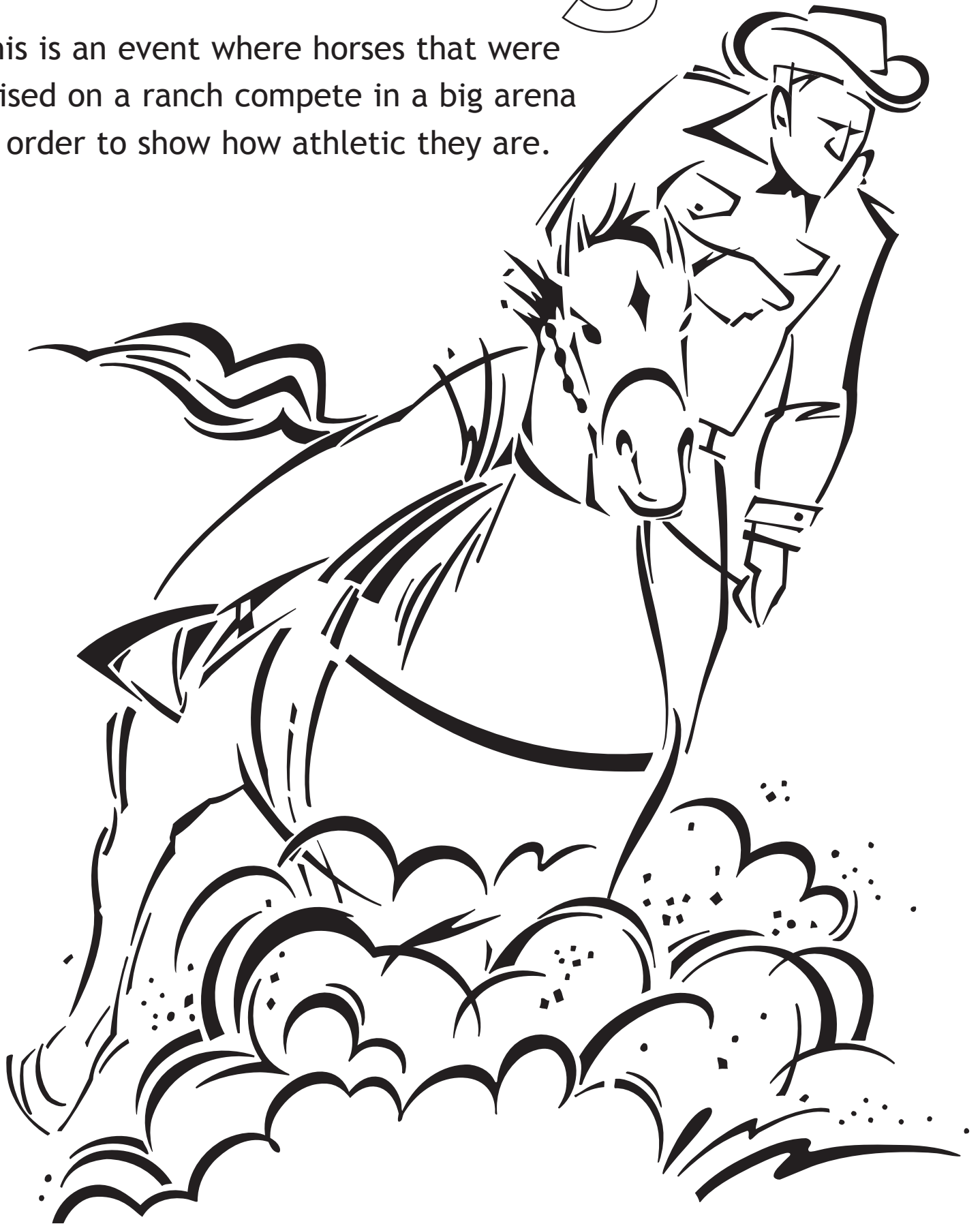


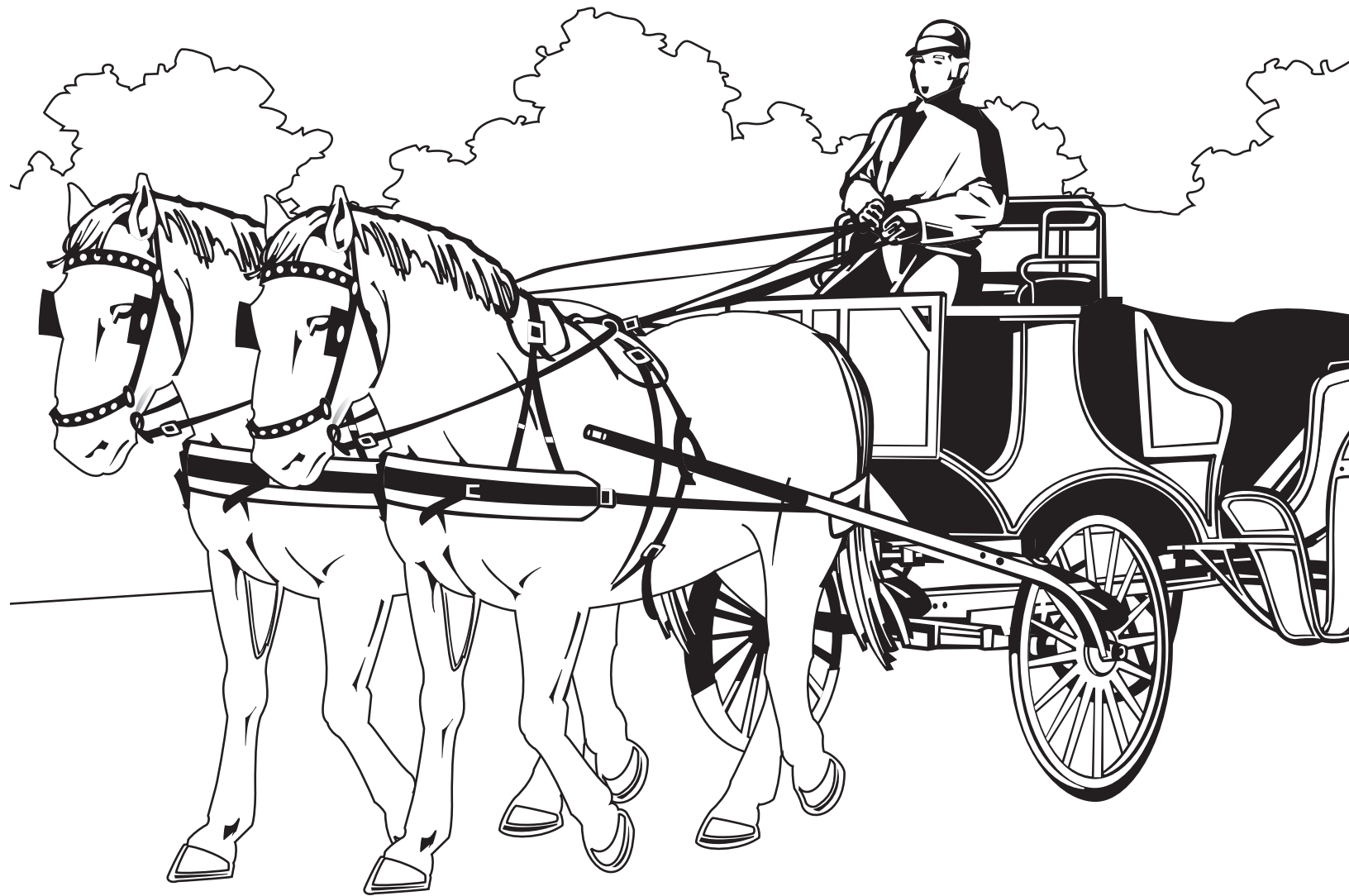

Reining

This is an event where horses that were raised on a ranch compete in a big arena in order to show how athletic they are.



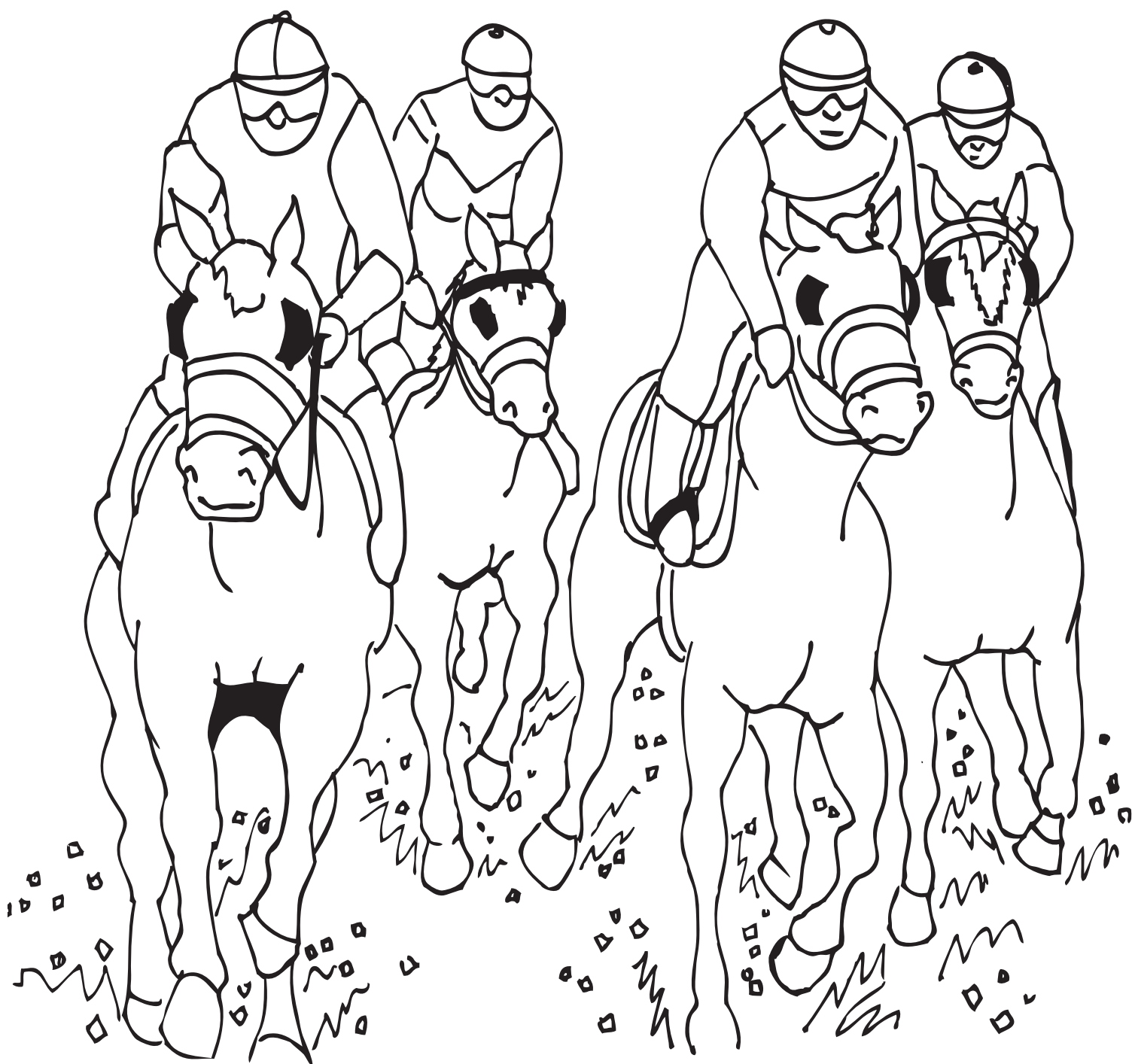


Driving

Driving is the oldest sport for horses. In this event the horses do not have riders; instead they are harnessed to a carriage or cart and pull it by themselves. The horse can do this by itself, with one other horse or in a team of 4 horses.

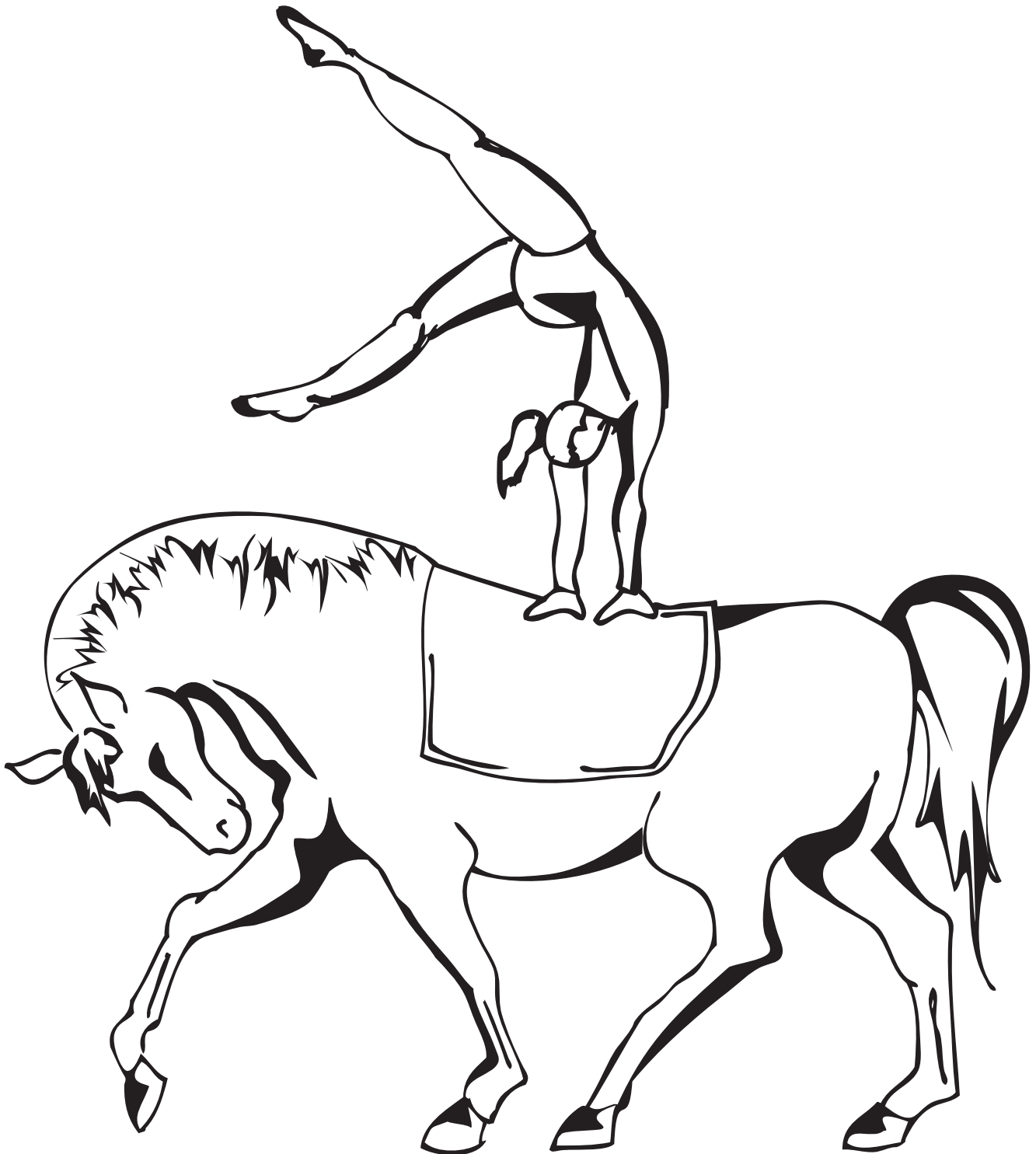
Endurance

This is a competition where horses race each other long distances, sometimes they run 100 miles! Whichever horse gets to the finish first, wins this competition.



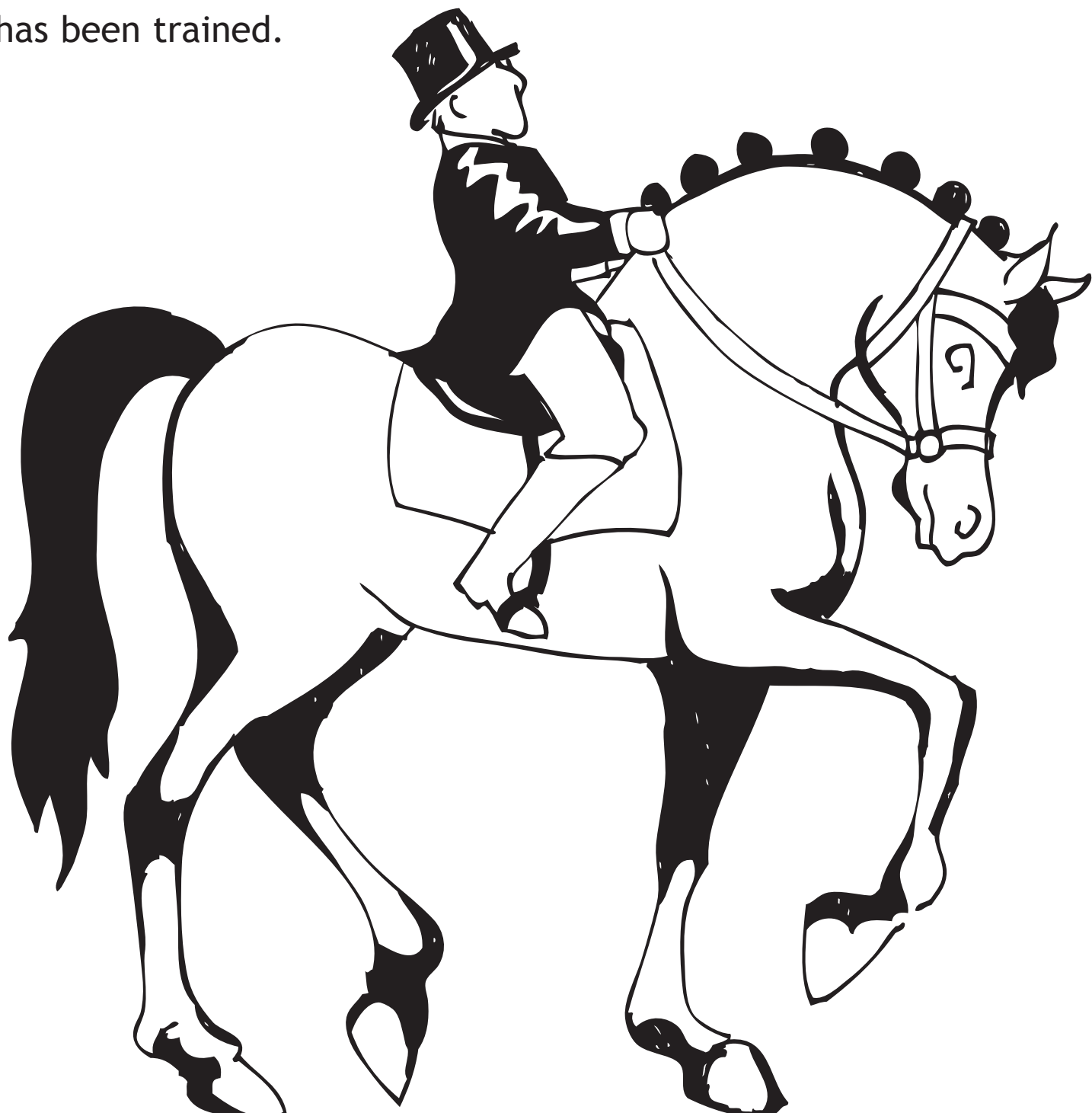
Vaulting

This is a competition where riders perform gymnastics on top of a horse while the horse is moving. The horse is going faster than a trot, but slower than a gallop.



Dressage

Just like your parents tell you to have good posture, horses need to have good posture too. Dressage is an event where judges look at how well a horse presents itself and how well they respond to the person riding them. All of these things show how well a horse has been trained.



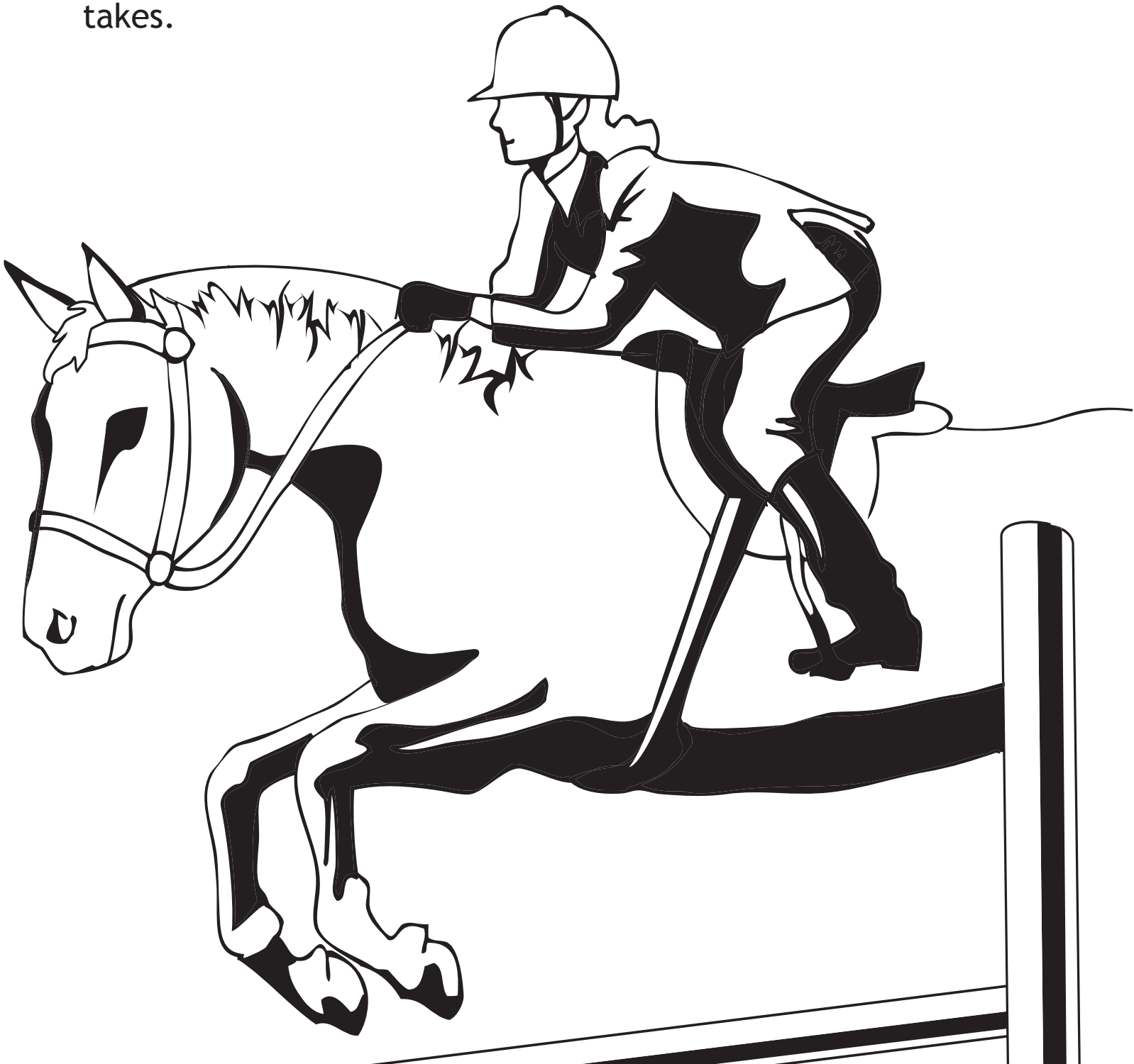


Eventing

In this event a horse is judged by its ability to jump over obstacles called hurdles and run long distances, this is called "cross country". Judges also look at how well the horse has been trained to listen to its rider, this is often called "dressage". This is an event that also takes place during the Olympics.

Show jumping

In this event a horse with a rider goes through an obstacle course with barriers, fences, gates and columns. The horses have to jump over these obstacles without making any mistakes.



Para-equestrian



This is a sport where Dressage and Driving take place together. The riders of the horses in this competition have disabilities. This will be the first time Para Equestrian has ever been held with the other 7 competitions listed.
